CHAPLIN BOARD OF FINANCE Chaplin, Connecticut Special Meeting Minutes March 26, 2018

Chairperson Dick Weingart called the meeting to order at 7:07 PM. Present were Board members Jean Lambert, Cesar Beltran, Alternate Linda Caron, and Alternate Matt Foster. Unable to attend were Board members Doug Dubitsky, Link Diwan and Marc Johnson; and Alternate Bill Jenkins. Others present were Superintendent Ken Henrici, CES Principal Patricia King, CES Board of Education Chair Jaclyn Chancey and Special Education Director Marcia McGinley.

3. SEATING OF ALTERNATES:

Alternate Linda Caron was seated for Board member Doug Dubitsky who could not attend tonight's meeting. Alternate Matt Foster was seated for Board member Marc Johnson who could not attend to night's meeting.

6. GUESTS: CHAPLIN BOARD OF EDUCATION & RSD11 BUDGET PRESENTATION:

Superintendent Henrici presented the following: budgets for the Chaplin Board of Education, RSD11 Board of Education and Central Office Committee; the COC assessment based on enrollment as of 10/01/17; and Special Education Data.

Chaplin Board of Education budget – 4% increase with one special education student that accounts for more than the entire increase (tuition and transportation). Three major items for the increase are contractual salaries, health insurance (increase 6.37%) and special education costs for STEM students. Talented & Gifted was folded into function 1000 (multiple teachers are filling multiple rolls).

Dick Weingart asked for Link Diwan how the demand for Special Education Services compared to other area small towns. Special Education Director Marcia McGinley reported that the percentage of students is below the state average with only one outplacement. She also reported that more special education students are moving into the district due to the services that are provided. Superintendent Henrici reported that the state has an excess cost grant to reimburse the towns for (cost per student times 4.5) with \$30-\$40,000 expected for reimbursement.

Cesar Beltran asked for the teacher/student ratio. There are 16 students per teacher for 2017-18.

Dick Weingart asked where this year's special education costs will be met in the budget. Superintendent Henrici reported there will be savings with the early retirement incentives (taken by three teachers) and the reduction of social work from full-time to part-time.

Central Office Committee – 8.96% increase that includes a Business Manager, increase from 1 to 2 days for the Special Education Director, 2.95% increase for Special Education Administrative Assistant and 6.37% increase for health insurance.

Dick Weingart asked for job description for Business Manager.

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Matt Foster asked about the Business Manager as a grant writer. Ashford has a Business Manager and receives many grants. Cesar Beltran suggested looking for someone who is retired.

The COC assessment based on enrollment is 35% for CES, 65% for PHHS and the Director of Special Education split 50/50. Enrollment for Chaplin Elementary is projected to increase.

RSD11 Board of Education – 0% increase with a 1.6 FTE reduction in staff. The RD11 Board asked for a budget that restores the reduction in staff and will be reviewed at the meeting on April 3rd. A Public Hearing will be held at 6:30pm followed by the regular meeting at 7pm.

 Dick Weingart presented updated Tax Collector Report with corrected amount for tax collected.

 Motion to accept Tax Collector Report for July 2017- February 2018, was made by Cesar Beltran,
 seconded by Jean Lambert and carried unanimously.
- b. Board Members reports:

Cesar Beltran presented informing regarding three Public Hearings by the Dissolution Committee for decision to not recommend Dissolution. They will be held on March 29th in Scotland, on April 2nd at the Chaplin Senior Center and on April 4th at the Hampton Town Hall.

8. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Regular meeting – 03/12/18; Special meeting – 03/19/18: Motion to remove from tabled the regular meeting minutes of 03/12/18, was made by Jean Lambert, seconded by Linda Caron and carried unanimously.

Motion to approve regular meeting minutes of 03/12/18, was made by Cesar Beltran with the following corrections: Item #5 correct the spelling for CIRMA. Item #5 under Town Memberships delete – Board of Finance consensus is to keep CCM. Item #5 under Employee Benefits and Costs should read – Link Diwan suggested a line item for retirement parties or similar purpose be included here. Item #7a should read – Effects on the Chaplin FY2019 budget of the Governor's proposed budget. Item #7a should read – Link Diwan suggested moving the deadline for filing the Annual Report to soon after the end of its fiscal year. Item #11b should read – Dick Weingart presented CCM and COST analysis of municipal aid in the Governor's budget that includes the effects of the budget on ECS and MBR, Town Aid Roads, and municipal spending cap. The motion was seconded by Jean Lambert and carried unanimously.

Motion to table the special meeting minutes of March 19, 2018, was made by Jean Lambert, seconded by Cesar Beltran and carried unanimously.
