- 1. Call to Order – Chairperson Jaclyn Chancey called the meeting to order at 6:38 pm. Board Members present were Laura Anderson, Eugene Boomer, Victor Boomer and William Hooper. Also in attendance were Superintendent Ken Henrici and Principal Kevin Chavez.**
