- 1. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 4:32pm
- 2. Members Present: Richard Weingart, Chair/Board of Finance; Jaclyn Chancey, Board of Education; Dave Stone, DPW Supervisor; Kevin Chavez, Principal CES; Joe Pinto, Chief Fire Department

3. Discuss and Act on CIP Plan:

#3325.1 Mr. Stone asked to keep handicapped access for Senior Center/Library open because the Board of Selectmen discussed on the steps due to ice buildup.

#3320.13 Mr. Weingart stated that \$5,000 was added to current year and next year.

#3320.12 The split HVAC Unit at Town Hall line item was overrun by \$793, which was added to 2020-21 to zero out to balance.

#3340.15 Remove Hurst Combination Tool under public safety

#3340.16 Ambulance service cancelled now that we are going through Windham contract

NEW HVAC Library/Senior Center \$30,000 this year and next year for new system needed in the next 3-4yrs; Board of Selectmen to decide when.

#3305.22 Town hall sidewalk replacement – funds can be redeployed

NEW Senior Center parking lot paving – can be split up between 2020-21 and 2021-22

NEW Fuel station upgrade – to be done in 2021-22

#3300.5 Remove repair damaged curbs/sidewalks

#3300.8 Remove duct system service

#3300.14 Gym Foam wall safety panels - added \$1500 to 2020-21

NEW Replace two boilers, need updated quote. To be split over next 2 fiscal years for 2 boilers, still need it in writing how much it will be.

Funding for the fireworks were discussed, Mr. Weingart stated that we can have an account as special revenue or capital improvement so funding can be rolled over from year to year. Donations will also be accepted which can be set up as a restricted account in the general fund.

The Capital Improvement Plan was reviewed by the committee and all members concurred that the plan is good and approved it (see attached)

4. Audience for Citizens:

Chris McKleroy asked the committee members to remove line item #3320.9 Relocate Museum seeing it was decided to not relocate it. The committee agreed that this should be a Board of Selectmen request to remove from the CIP plan.
