HE WILL SPEAK WITH JIM LARKIN FROM THE REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENT, WHO IS WORKING ON CHAPLIN'S AFFORDABLE HOUSING PLAN, TO SEE WHAT STEPS WE NEED TO TAKE TO CREATE A PLAN TO MERGE THE LAND WITH A HOUSING CONCEPT.

THE COMMISSION DISCUSSED THE PROPOSED GAS/CONVENIENCE STORE AS A PUBLIC HEARING IS SOON, RESTAURANTS ARE VACANT AND WE SHARED THOUGHTS ABOUT DEALING WITH THAT.
