Irene is planning on attending an event in Northford, CT. on June 17th. to learn more about the industry and to meet and network with others involved in hop growing and brewing. The Connecticut Hop Growers Association is conducting seminars and demonstrations at the DeFrancesco Farm.

Peggy and Irene met with Miria Toth, Norwich Economic Dev. Dept. She also organizes the Bozrah Farmers Market which has been quite a success. They have 6 volunteers who run the market, and about 38 vendors each week.
