My child is difficult to motivate to participate in school work outside of the classroom environment. She is quite uninterested in the whole process without the teacher/peer interaction that she would normally have.

Distance learning is designed for families with only 1 or 2 children who have no special needs and both parents can devote the entire day to supporting and modifying work.

The amount of work is sufficient to maintain/learn new skills, however, when you add in the technology piece (uploading, problem solving tech) it takes the majority of my child's day to get work done with little no downtime. I am working full time from home, therefore getting it all in is daunting. Also, please look in to how 504 plans are being implemented. Will missed time be made up for kids when staff cancel 504 support times? My child's input is the videos are too long (he loses interest in the topic). Thank you for taking the time to gather info from families!

We've had several delays with our online learning but reading never stops and the learning has now included some home economics. We miss you Mrs O!!!!

So far Jaina has adapted nicely to online learning. It took a little while to figure out how to navigate through the google platform but the teaches have done an excellent job in Middle Academy to show how everything works. They have put the time and effort into the lessons for the class and made themselves available for meetings and assistance. I think it would be beneficial for the kids if the teachers were able to arrange a class meeting either with the whole class or small groups so they can all touch base.

While our technology isn't a problem, we struggle with my student completing her work without significant help due to complications of completing the work electronically, and I myself often have a difficult time, due to how it's posted to be completed.

Some of the books with audio added are good. Youtube videos are good and is not a site the requires remembering another login! Be sure there is an instructional video for concepts an hours throughout the day to ask/learn it. Don't just post a worksheet they might not know how to do.

This format makes for easier differentiation.

Its stressful to see all this homework for my kiddo while still working. I did not expect art and music and gym to be something i would also be getting for homework on top of his classwork i only have 1 maybe 2 days off a week of work being a nurse and i see all the emails come in while at work doing 11 hour shifts and i cant keep up with my childs honework and i really want to make shore hes where he is supposed to be. I hurd that children with IEPs where going to get new tablets that he can just do work and hit the submitted button and go right to the next ones im really hoping thats something thats put in motion because it would be alot easier then printing taking pictures finding the correct email that i printed from and submitting it properly iust takes an hour nevermind having my child sit and do his work. Overall i think everyone is doing great and i know this is not easy and i give everyone an A+ i really do but its a little hard on moms end haha so i hope we can get them new tablets to make it a little easier.

The teachers are doing a good job, but we would like more quick instructional videos for parents with materials that we can print out and then do with our children. Kindergarten is doing very well with this. It is very important to us that our children NOT be required to have a lot of screen time. We have been doing circle time, calendar, read alouds and other outdoor hands on learning/teaching of our children. We understand that not all parents can do this or want this but it is very important to us in the raising and education of our children. We have been compiling our children's work in a folder and dating things, but do not have the time to scan or mail in all that we have completed. If necessary, we will turn this into our kiddo's teachers when/if school opens back up. Thank you to everyone working hard to keep school going one way or another!

I am having a wonderful time teaching my Pre-K students at home. And anytime I have a question, I've always gotten an answer from the teachers. I've never had any problem with them. I'm thankful for the teachers and the teachers helpers. But I do not want the schools to open back up this year. I'd like to think about opening up in September.
