SUBJECT OF HEARING:

HB6107 - Accessory Apartment Opt-Out:

The Commission is considering Accessory Apartments Opt-Out provisions from HB6107 section 5 (pg. 12-13) and section 6e (pg. 15-16).

The hearing was opened for public comments.

Public comments in favor of proposed Accessory Apartment Opt-Out:

- First Selectman Juan Roman in favor of the opt-out that would be beneficial to the town. The state should not be allowed to dictate the town's zoning regulations.
- Bob Dubos of Bedlam Road in favor of the opt-out and fears greed would take over to build apartments that don't belong here if the state is allowed to dictate the town's zoning regulations.
- Adele Swart of Tower Hill Road in favor of the opt-out. The zoning regulations should be left up to the PZC that best knows the wishes of the residents and the rural nature of the town.
- Kitty LeShay of Tower Hill Road in favor of the opt-out and doesn't think apartments belong in the
 very rural town of Chaplin. Residents should have a say in what the character of the town looks like,
 not the state.
