Public Hearing Minutes
April 11, 2017**

Chairperson Steve Dunn called the Public Hearing to order at 6:36 PM. Present were Board members Kate Donnelly, Sally Ireland, Bud Smallwood, Jennifer Nelson and Stephanie Harrington (6:45 PM). Unable to attend were Board members Rose Bisson, Stacy Foster and Kathleen O’Callaghan. Administrators present was Superintendent Ken Henrici.

2. PUBLIC HEARING ON 2017-18 REGION #11 BUDGET:

The Region #11 budget has a 0% increase. Areas that impact the budget are health insurance, magnet tuition and contractual salaries. The COC assessment ratio was revised from 69% - RD11/31% - CES to 64% - RD11/36% - CES and is based on enrollment. The Board will be asked to approve recommendation of \$300,000 to offset town assessments. There is still a lot of uncertainty of funding cuts with the Governor’s budget. Steve Dunn reported that the vast majority of other districts in the state will not develop a budget based on what ifs.

Kathy Donahue asked if the budget was adjusted to reflect a projected decline in enrollment and the number of staff and paraprofessionals. Superintendent Henrici reported that there is not a decline in services and there are 36 staff with 11 paraprofessionals.

Bud Smallwood commended the administration for development of the budget with tight financial constraints.

3. METHOD OF VOTING FOR ADOPTION OF BUDGET:

Kate Donnelly expressed concerns with voting for the budget at a referendum.

Motion to hold a Referendum on May 2, 2017 from 12-8pm at each town’s respective polling place for adoption of the FY 17-18 Budget, was made by Jennifer Nelson, seconded by Sally Ireland and carried with the following vote:

YES: B. Smallwood, S. Ireland, S. Dunn, S. Harrington, J. Nelson.

NO: K. Donnelly.

4. ADJOURNMENT:

Motion to adjourn (6:52 PM) was made by Jennifer Nelson, seconded by Sally Ireland and carried unanimously.
