New Business: 152 England Rd. Mr. Keith Crocker, notice of violation, filling adjacent to wetlands/application to perform drainage improvements. Grading in upland review area.

The purpose of the activity is to improve the current drainage issues, specifically the storm water discharges from England Road.

Agent J. Theroux explained the location of the wetlands on the town GIS mapping and that only minimal filling occurred in the wetlands.

He continued further explaining how the stormwater and drainage flows into the stream, pond and wetlands.

It was the consensus of the Commission that a site walk is warranted and it is planned for June 4^{th} , 2024 at 5:45 PM.
