1. **Call to Order**: Mr. Roman called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

2. Roll Call

- 3. Discussion and possible action on the Board of Selectmen setting an interim mill rate for FY 2024-2025 in accordance with CGS § 12-123. J Roman asked BOF Chair Dick Weingart to review the discussion from the previous paused Board of Finance Meeting. D Weingart explained that the recently revised FY 2024-2025 Budget was supported with a mill rate of 29.95. K Fortier asked if the mill rate will go down with the next proposed FY 2024-2025 Budget. D Weingart responded that it won't be higher. By setting the mill rate at this meeting, the Board of Selectman will set the tax billing into motion with a target billing date of August 1, 2024 which will include a grace period until September 3rd. If a budget passes with a lower mill rate after the tax billing, Tax Collector Lisa Madden explained that the taxpayers will have two options: 1. Taxes paid in excess may be put toward next year's taxes or 2. The taxpayer can request, in writing, a refund of the excess from the Tax Collector. Joe Pinto made a MOTION for the Board of Selectmen to set an interim mill rate, in accordance with CGS § 12-123, of 29.95 mills to be billed on August 1, 2024 with a grace period of payment until September 3, 2024. K Fortier seconded the MOTION. All in favor, MOTION carried.
