 Smith. They discussed the need for the Special Town Meeting not to
 interfere with Early Voting which will be taking place at the Senior Center
 during the last two weeks of October. A Special Town Meeting date of
 Monday, October 21, 2024 was decided on. This special Town Meeting will
 take place at the Chaplin Volunteer Fire Department as not to disrupt
 Early Voting at the senior Center. The BOS will hold its own Special
 Meeting on October, 8 2024 to approve the Special Town Meeting
 Warning to be published.

- B. <u>Discussion and possible action on Polling Locations</u>: The technical requirements have been met at the Ferrara Community Room that will allow the Registrar of Voters to access the Connecticut Voter Registration System which is required during Early Voting.
