

Chaplin Public Library Announces January's Museum of the Month The Old State House

800 Main St, Hartford, CT 06103



This is the oldest state house in the nation and is beautifully restored and preserved. Declared one of the first National Historic Landmarks in 1960, our Old State House has a mix of historic rooms and modern exhibits with educational programs, tours and exhibits for the general public, and year-round special events that focus on Connecticut history and civics. Major state and national events have, and continue to occur at the Old State House. Lafayette was made a citizen here, many American presidents, including Jackson, Monroe, Johnson, Ford and Bush have visited. President Carter gave the U.S.S. Nautilus to Connecticut in a ceremony at the Old State House in 1981. The trials of Cinque and the Amistad opened here in 1839. P.T. Barnum served in the legislature here. You can see it all!


