B. FY 2025/2026 General Fund Budget Request:

Reviewed current budget cut \$2,500 from last year (will be another tough budget year for the town). Motion for the Chair and Treasurer to produce a budget request with 2.5% increase over the current year, made by Dave Stone, seconded by Danny Cates and carried unanimously.

- Motion to spend up to \$400 on 50-inch TV for Community Room, made by Dave Stone, seconded by Danny Cates and carried unanimously.
- C. Ice Skating: Ice Rink setup and available for any member that would like to do an event.

D. Indoor games/Open night:

Received inquiry about opening Community Room gym one night a week to come in to practice or play would need 1 Rec member to open and stay (Danny suggested a pop-up, Josh suggested people send message on as needed basis).

E. Bingo:

Discussed starting monthly Bingo - permit cost \$50 annually (Dave suggested showcasing a local restaurant with catering and charge per plate).

Motion to approve \$50 annual fee for Bingo, made by Dave Stone, seconded by Amie Kraemer and carried unanimously.
